Welcome to Information Bulletin No. 2 from the Organising Committee of *Tampa 2011*. Keep up-to-date by visiting the *Tampa 2011* website: <http://tampa2011.idbfworldchamps.com>

Tampa 2011 will consist of the 10th WDBRC and the 1st Pan American Club Crew Championships, plus the IDBF Congress, during the period 30th July – 8 August 2011 inclusive. Further Information on the Pan Am Championship and the IDBF Congress, will be sent out separately. World Championship Racing will take place from 3 -7 August inclusive, with the Opening Ceremony on Tuesday 2 August 2011. Competing Teams for the WDBRC are expected to arrive in Tampa between Friday 29 July and Monday 1 August 2011.

PROVISIONAL ENTRIES or an Intention to Compete, have been notified by 32 IDBF Members from:- Australia, Brazil, Canada, Chile, China, Chinese Taipei , Czech Republic, France, Germany, Ghana, Great Britain, Hungary, Hong Kong, India, Italy, Japan, Macau, New Zealand, the Netherlands, Norway, the Philippines, Poland, Puerto Rico, Russia, Senegal, Singapore, Sweden, Trinidad & Tobago, Uganda, Ukraine, United Arab Emirates and the United States. Of these 24 IDBF Members submitted Provisional Entries by the due date.

1. **HOTEL ACCOMODATION:** The Tampa 2011, Organizing Committee has arranged a variety of hotel accommodation ranging from USD 22.25 (multiple occupancy) to USD 189.00 (single occupancy) per person, per night, ***including breakfast** and 12% tax. Costs do NOT include the IDBF Registration Fee of USD 15, per person or Hotel Dinner costs.

**** Howard Johnson **** is in reserve for the IDBF to allocate as subsidized housing for developing nations or those with financial difficulties. Applicants who wish to receive approval for subsidized housing must directly contact the IDBF.



2. TRANSPORTATION:

Transportation to and from the Official Hotels is not needed, as all are within walking distance. The furthest properties at 1.4 km (1 mile) from the Venue have complimentary shuttle services available.

Transfers from and to Tampa International Airport, will be provided by *Tampa 2011*, for Teams booking Official Hotels through *Tampa 2011*, at no extra cost. Transport from Orlando Airport can be arranged at an additional cost. Teams must provide *Tampa 2011* arrival and departure information no later than 4 July 2011.

Please note that transportation to your hotel and the race venue is NOT complimentary to teams that do not book through *Tampa 2011* to stay at the Official World Championship Hotels.

Teams making their own Hotel arrangements will be required to book their own transport for airport transfers and daily transport to the race venue. This can be done through *Tampa 2011*. Airport transportation is approximately USD 22.00 return, per person. *Tampa 2011* can also arrange transportation for Teams making their own Hotel arrangements, based on request and Team size. See Appendix.1 for booking form and Appendix.5 for payments.

3. LUNCHEES ON RACE DAYS:

A buffet style lunch will be provided, in the Tampa Convention Centre on Racing Days (Wed 3 August to Sunday 7 August 2011), for those Teams booking Official Hotels, at a cost of USD 8.00, per person, per day. Race Day Lunches may be purchased for Teams staying outside of the Official Hotels at a cost of USD 10.00, per person, per day.

All Lunches must be pre-booked and paid for by the closing date for Named Entries on 27 June 2011. Teams requiring lunches on training days should contact *Tampa 2011* to discuss arrangements. Please see Appendix.2 for Lunches booking worksheet and Appendix.5 for methods of payment.

4. CELEBRATION DINNER:

The Celebration Dinner on the evening of 7 August 2011 will be held at the Tampa Convention Center. Tickets include food and entertainment and will cost USD 25.00, per person attending. Tickets can be purchased in advanced, and payment must be received by the closing date for Named Entries on 27 June 2011. Tickets will also be available the week of the Championships for USD 30.00, per person attending. Please see Appendix.2 for Celebration Dinner booking worksheet and Appendix.5 for methods of payment.

5. ADMINISTRATION FEE:

Teams who make their own accommodation arrangements will pay the full Administration Fee shown below for each person shown on the Final Named Entry Form.

The Championship Administration fee all for Teams, including Official Supporters, will be USD 40.00 per person but for those staying in the Official Hotels and booking through *Tampa 2011*, as above, this fee will be reduced to USD 30.00 per person, to reflect Hotel discounts given for block bookings. All fees must be paid with the Final Named Entries on 27 June 2011. Please see Appendix.2 for Admin Fee worksheet and Appendix.5 for methods of payment.

6. IDBF REGISTRATION FEE:

An IDBF Registration Fee of USD 15.00, per person, will be payable directly to the IDBF in respect of every participant attending the World Championships. This includes official supporters as shown on the Final Named Entry Form. Payment details are included below. The increase in Registration Fee from USD 10.00 to USD 15.00 will help to provide a more comprehensive range of IDBF services to the paddlers. See also Appendix.5 for payment details.

CONFIRMED & NAMED ENTRIES – ONLINE REGISTRATION:

TEAM PROFILES:

Teams will be able to submit a short (100 words max) team profile and a single photo for publication in the Souvenir Programme. **Text and photo can be submitted at any time up to Sunday, 4 July 2011.** Submissions must be sent via email to Christine Canevari, ccanevari@tampabaydragonboats.com.

NATIONAL FLAGS & ANTHEMS:

Each team taking part in the 10th IDBF World Dragon Boat Racing Championship is asked to bring with them two (2) Official Representative Flags for their country or territory, of a size approximately 1m (6ft) x 0.5m (3ft). One flag will be utilized at the Opening Ceremony for the Parade of Nations, and the other will be utilized for Medals Ceremonies. Flags must be delivered to the Org Com Accreditation Room no later than Monday, 1 August 2011 at 5 pm.

Please also provide an electronic file of your Country's or Territory's official anthem to Christine Canevari, ccanevari@tampabaydragonboats.com by 4 July 2011. Preferred file types are .mpeg or .mp3, no larger than 5MB.



ENTRY CONDITIONS

ALL COMPETITION CLASSES (Only one Entry per Team, per Competition Class, is permitted).

The Small Boat Championships are primarily for developing IDBF Members – normally Basic and Associate Members, who have not taken part in a WDBRC for at least 4 years. **By exception** IDBF Members who have taken part in a WDBRC in the past four years but who are unable to send Standard Boat Premier, Junior A and Senior A Crews, may be permitted to compete in the Small Boat Championships, in these Racing Classes, at the discretion of the Chairman of the IDBF C&TC. Any IDBF Member who is unable to field Standard Boats in the developing Racing Classes – that is Junior B, Under 23s and Senior B, may enter these specific Small Boat competitions.

The same competitors cannot compete in both the Standard Boat and Small Boat Championships in the same competition class, except that competitors in an Open or Women’s Standard Boat can compete in a Mixed Small Boat when there are less than 18 paddlers in either crew. Additionally, if a Team enters the 1000m and/or 2000m in the Standard Boat it cannot enter the Small Boat 200m and 500m races. **Examples of ‘exceptions’ are shown in the Entry Matrix below.**

STANDARD Boat Championships will be held over 200m, 500m, 1000m and 2000m for the Competitions shown below.

Standard Mixed Crews = min of 8 and max of 12 female paddlers. **Reserve Paddlers:** Maximum of Four (4)

SMALL BOAT Championships will be held over 200m and 500m only.

Small Mixed Crews = min of 4 and max of 6 female paddlers. **Reserve Paddlers:** Maximum of Two (2).

Age Regulations: **Senior A** – Age 40 or over, **Senior B (Grand Dragons)** – age 50 or over as of 1 June 2011

Junior A – Under 18 but 12 or over. **Junior B** – Under 16 but 12 or over as of 1 Jan. 2011

U23 – Under 23 but 18 or over as of 1 Jan. 2011 (6 crew members may be U18 - Small Boat 3)

ENTRY MATRIX – STANDARD AND SMALL BOAT CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Matrix is designed to help Teams decide which mix of Standard and Small Boat competitions they can enter. It is based on the condition that IDBF Full Members should mainly enter the Standard Boat races and only enter the Small Boat Races in developing racing classes, such as U23s, Junior B.
